Our Program

No prior Russian is required to join this exciting experiential learning adventure in Armenia and Georgia!



Students will study Russian at Yerevan State University and Tbilisi State University, visit 5 UNESCO World Heritage Sites, important museums, gorgeous mountainous landscapes, and ancient archeological sites.

Students will also live in Yerevan and Tbilisi, immerse themselves in two architecturally unique cities, and enjoy some of the most famous cuisine in Europe

Students earn 9 to 11 credit hours:
Contemporary Issues in Russian Society & Culture, taught in English: 3 credit hrs
Russian language courses: 6-8 credit hrs

Expected Program Costs

Program Fee*	~\$3,500
Airfare	~\$1,800
Tuition	\$338/credit hour
Food	~\$100/week

*Includes accommodation, instruction and textbooks, ground transportation, day- and weekend-long cultural activities, international health insurance, breakfasts and lunches in Armenia, and some other group meals.

Additional costs include personal expenses and mandatory UGA fees.
